Greenvale Reservoir Park Road Repairs

July 2025

In November 2024, the Victorian Government committed to re-opening the southern section Greenvale Reservoir Park. The northern and southern sections of Greenvale Reservoir Park will soon be connected, offering more access to recreational space for the local community.

Melbourne Water and Parks Victoria are working together to reopen the Greenvale Reservoir Park, undertaking basic work to make the area safe for the public while also protecting Melbourne's water supplies.

What do the works involve?

Some of the works include construction of a new 250m water pipe connection to the park. The pipe will connect the existing Yuroke tank located within the northern section of the park, to the southern parkland area.

Local impacts

We do not expect any significant impacts to the local community from these works. However, access to some areas of the northern park may be temporarily reduced for safety during construction.

Pedestrian traffic management and temporary fencing will be implemented around the work area as needed.

Residents and pathway users within the Reservoir Park may notice increased activity and noise from vehicles and machinery at the work site.

The works will be conducted on weekdays from 7:00am - 5:00pm.
